#### What is Lapacho?

Lapacho is the colloquial name for a tree species up to 35 m high with the lat. Name "Tabebuia avellanedae", whose bark is called in Portuguese Ipê-roxo, Pau d'arco, which translates as "Lapacho bark" means. The tree can reach an age of over 700 years. It belongs to the family of trumpet tree family and is widespread in Central and South America. The Lapacho bark has an unusually high content of minerals and trace elements.

#### **Harvesting of Lapacho bark**

Harvesting is preferably done in summer to take advantage of the low to take advantage of the low rainfall period. Winter is avoided because of the high humidity, which affects the quality of the product. The harvesting period is about 90 days.
